- ✓ Insurance card and prescriptions (check legal status)
- **V** Power adapter/converter for your destination country
- ✓ Laptop/tablet, chargers, and backups

3. Packing Checklist

- **V** Layered, climate-appropriate clothing
- **V** Comfortable walking shoes and culturally appropriate attire
- ✓ Toiletries and first-aid/medication kit
- V Reusable water bottle, day-pack, rain jacket, or umbrella
- **V** Small comfort item or host family gift
- **X** Avoid overpacking leave space for souvenirs!

4. Arrival & First-Week Checklist

- **V** Attend orientation and register with your host institution
- **V** Set up a local bank account or payment app
- **V** Familiarise yourself with local transport and safety info
- **V** Meet your academic advisor and residential support
- **V** Check accommodation utilities, security, and internet
- **V** Explore nearby essentials (supermarket, pharmacy, hospital)

5. Study & Life Abroad Tips

- **V** Visit student services for academic or personal support
- ✓ Track your budget and keep an emergency fund

- ◆ Be open-minded and respectful of local customs
- **V** Keep copies of key documents and emergency contacts
- ✓ Stay engaged with your studies and meet deadlines

6. Return Home Checklist

- ✓ Complete departure paperwork with host institution
- ✓ Return all accommodation keys/items
- **V** Collect final transcripts or credit transfer paperwork
- **V** Reflect on your experience photos, journal, blog
- **V** Plan your next steps (internships, further study, career)
